Guest Speakers Presentation:

- Lori Sumner, Humana Military Managed Care Support Liaison, introduced herself and gave background on the services offered by Humana, ECHO and Tricare.
- PowerPoint available on MCCS website
 - Speaker outlined Power Point
 - o Although ECHO has a 90 day processing duration benefits start immediately after applying. Benefits will be terminated if ALL required paperwork is not received during 90 day duration. Service Member must also enroll in EFMP during these 90 days - it is a requirement of ECHO.
 - o Being homebound or partially homebound qualifies ECHO recipients for Home Health Care.
 - o Know your Tricare zone. There are 3 Tricare zones in the United States.
 - o Referrals are required for Tricare Prime and ABA Therapy
 - Conclusion: Speaker took a moment for Q&A with attendees and provided contact information for additional questions.

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□ Tracy Fearon, MCFTB Director: Gave an overview of the programs Family Team Building offers.

- Speaker delivered a short briefing.
 - Classes/trainings are still being held in person, no more than 10 participants for social distancing due to Covid-19.
 - Virtual volunteering is now available.
- Conclusion: Contact information and office location provided.

□ Danielle Mathis, Navy Housing Installation Program Manager (Oceana), provided useful information about Military housing and available resources.

- Limited amount of ADA compliant housing.
- Providing Status Update letter, LoN 4 move up to top 10% on waiting list.
- Minor ADA compliant modifications/adaptations can be made to current available housing units upon request.
- For homes outside of Military Housing Communities, a representative will come out to inspect Property and assist with the process of receiving ADA upgrades (upon request).
- Conclusion: Speaker took a moment for Q&A with attendees and provided contact information for additional questions.
